AVISTA REBATE

Doug Kelly from **Avista** has informed us that our Central project is scheduled for a rebate from Avista because of the energy efficiencies that we have incorporated within our facility. Based on their calculations we will receive an incentive rebate of \$145,975. In addition, because our building will meet Silver LEED standards, we will receive an additional \$1.50/sq. ft of conditioned space for an additional rebate of \$111,457 resulting in a total projected rebate for our Central project of \$257,432! This is terrific news for our project in recognition of the emphasis we have given to energy savings for our future Central Y operations.

PAUL G. ALLEN FOUNDATION GRANT

We have just received word that we will receive a \$200,000 grant from the **Paul G. Allen Family Foundation**. We are extremely grateful for their generous support at a time when this foundation is reconsidering their future priorities for funding.
